- Remitting fees in any one of the branches of SBI/PNB/UBI.
- Entry of payment details in the website
- Postal submission of the institute copy of challan by speed post/registered post to ISAT office and/or uploading the copy in ISAT website.

IIST ADMISSION TEST ISAT-2012

The Indian Institute of Space Science and Technology (IIST), 'Declared as Deemed to be University' under section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, established by the Department of Space, Government of India, offers undergraduate (B.Tech in Aerospace Engineering, Avionics and Physical Sciences), post-graduate and doctoral programmes in niche areas of space science, technology and applications. IIST is a residential institution located at Valiamala, approximately 20 Kilometres from Thiruvananthapuram city. It has separate hostel facilities for boys and girls. At present, IIST has about 700 students and 80 faculty members. Students who complete the B.Tech programme of IIST, meeting specified academic standards, will be absorbed into ISRO as Scientists / Engineers. The expenditure for tuition fees, hostel accommodation and boarding, etc. is borne by IIST for every student subject to performance standards set by IIST.

IIST now invites applications for admission to its B.Tech Programmes in Aerospace Engineering, Avionics and Physical Sciences for the academic year 2012-13. Admission to the B.Tech programme will be through the IIST Admission Test (ISAT-2012) to be held on Saturday, 21st April, 2012 in Twenty Two cities across the country. Candidates for ISAT-2012 have to register online at the **IIST website :www.iist.ac.in/isat2012** and follow the instructions therein.

The on-line registration begins on 1st November, 2011 at 10:00 am and will continue up to 31st December, 2011, 11:30pm.

EXAMINATION FEE:

Candidates residing in India: The examination fee for candidates in GEN¹ and OBC² categories is Rs.600/- and the fee for SC³, ST⁴, PD⁵ and female candidates in all categories is Rs.300/-. The examination fee is non-refundable. The fee has to be remitted in any one of the branches of State Bank of India (SBI), Punjab National Bank (PNB) or Union Bank of India (UBI) by using the challan (in triplicate) which can be downloaded/printed on successful completion of on-line registration. **Fee remitted in any other form will not be accepted.**

NRI candidates: NRI Candidates can remit their examination fee through any bank outside India. The fee must be sent in the form of a Demand Draft drawn in favour of **THE REGISTRAR, IIST** payable at **THIRUVANANTHAPURAM**. Demand Draft issued from a bank within India will **NOT BE ACCEPTED**.

GEN¹ - Genral Category, OBC² - Other Backward Classes, SC³ - Scheduled Castes, ST⁴ - Scheduled Tribes, PD⁵ - Physically Disabled.
